

VARIETY CHARACTERISTICS

General

Alegria is a second early till medium early maincrop variety, with a very high yield and good resistance to drought. Alegria gives a strong medium tall plant with white flowers and a quick soil coverage. It is intended for the freshmarket and also very suitable for home fries.

CULTIVATION ADVICE

Soil

Alegria can be grown on all types of soil. Pre-sprouting is not necessary. In terms of weed control we advise to use milder chemicals, but Alegria is not sensitive for a normal dose of Metribuzin. Because of a slight sensitivity for Rhizoctonia we don't advise to plant Alegria in a cold soil. A chemical treatment from both soil and seedpotato is highly recommended. On extremely dry soiles and in the Mediterranean irrigation is recommended.

Adapt fertilization per HA to soil analysis

Nitrogen	160 to 200 kilogram	
Phosfate	80 to 100 kilogram	
Potasium	220 to 250 kilogram	
Magnesium	50 to 70 kilogram	
Manure is not advised.slightly during the autumn soil preparation.		

Planting, harvesting & storage


Alegria needs a short planting distance. For the seedpotato size 28/35: 75 cm x 28 cm & the seedpotato size 35/50: 75 cm x 32 cm. Alegria is little sensitive to bruising, but carefully harvesting is always the message. Alegria preserves long in storage.
